Dear Agudas Achim Congregants,

We do hope you are holding up okay despite these most difficult times. Please reach out to the office if you are in need of any help. This letter is an update on behalf of the board and myself.

Though we are unsure of plans for returning to minyanim & services, we are committed to returning only when it seems safest and with proper social distancing protocols. We are keeping abreast of what is recommended by the Governor, the Board of Rabbis, and the JewishColumbus Medical Advisory Board.

The local Orthodox rabbis recently sent out a statement with which we strongly agree:

"Although the Ohio economy has begun opening in stages, we have determined that it is premature to begin opening our doors for davening. Our sole consideration is the preservation of health and human life. At the present time, it still remains unclear as to when the appropriate time for reopening our shuls will be. We ask you to continue exerting patience as we monitor the overall effects of the economy's opening. It is critical that our community abide by one standard so as not to undermine our collective efforts to mitigate the spread of the disease."

Additionally, we have been meeting about the High Holidays with Rabbi Morris Allen, and are working on thoughtful plans about how we will have to adapt. Clearly this year will be different. The guidelines are still evolving so it is too soon to share any exact plans. That said, it will definitely be a hybrid model. We will keep you posted on a regular basis as plans continue to come together. Thanks for your understanding as we make our way through these uncharted waters.

A new High Holiday Task Force is being formed by Natalie Cohen, who has many creative ideas of meaningful ways for us to connect to each other and our tradition during this year's High Holidays. We are encouraged that the Agudas Achim/Tifereth Israel representatives are energized and are interviewing professional facilitators this week and next! We will keep you posted on their facilitator decision as soon as we know it.

We are looking to purchase and install audio/visual equipment in the main sanctuary for folks to access our services who may be unable or uncomfortable coming to shul when we are able to reopen, and especially on the high holidays. If you are in a position to contribute to a special fund for this equipment, it would be very much appreciated since this was not in our budget. The project totals approximately \$8,000.
