

In light of COVID-19, JCC Ranch Camp has made the difficult decision to cease 'usual' summer operations and turn our program over into a weekly family rental program.

We will be running **six "Family Sessions" (Wednesday to Sunday) over the course of the summer.** Families can participate in our smaller program, with the option to **book individual cabins or cottages.** Families will have the opportunity to participate in outside activities, such as **hiking, high ropes, sports, art,** and more! Activities will be done in **small multi-family groups,** operating with both **healthy physical distance and appropriate protective equipment in place.**

Each cabin/cottage space can only be occupied by an individual family during their stay. Note: this can also include anyone who has been living in their home with them for the two weeks preceding their registered session.

**\*Running this program is contingent upon the current and updated recommendations of the federal, state, and local government.** Although Ranch Camp is located in Elbert County, we will be adopting the direction provided by Denver County officials.

# CANCELLATION POLICIES

Ranch Camp has a 24-hour cancellation policy. If you need to cancel for any reason within 24-hours of registering, you will receive a full refund.

<b>Cancellations made between...</b>
<b>Cancellation Fee...</b>
Within the first 7 days of completing your registration
\$250 cancellation fee*
Between the first 7 days of completing your registration and 10 days out from your session start
50% of your total session tuition
Within 10 days of your session start
75% of your total session tuition

*These firm cancellation policies are in place to help keep our community safe, but also to ensure Ranch Camp is here for the summers to come. A majority of expenses for Family Camp are non-refundable or transferable. This includes items such as food, disinfectant supplies, and the salaries of our fantastic seasonal staff at Ranch Camp, without whose dedication and commitment this program would not run.*

The Denver JCC is finalizing its cancellation policy should the JCC not be able to operate any summer programs due to COVID-19. This policy will be sent out early next week. **Once this policy is sent out, families will have a 48-hour grace period to cancel their registration with no fees.**

Assigned shower in nearby bathhouse

Bathing suits & sandals

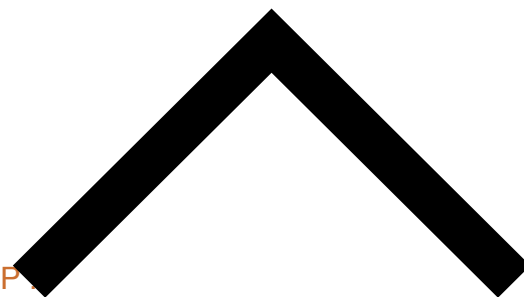
Toiletries (i.e. dental products, shampoo, soap, etc.)

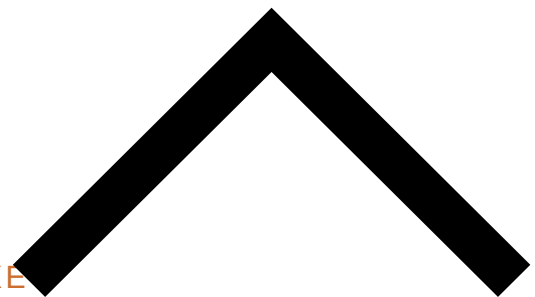

WHAT DOES A DAY AT RANCH CAMP LOOK LIKE

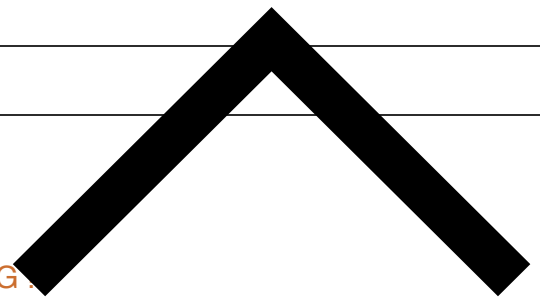

Sanitizer stations in each village

Assigned showers

Delivered/outdoor meals

Sanitized program areas

Under 10 person activity groups

Provided gloves for shared program areas

Disinfected campus in between each weekly session

Staff on two-week quarantine at camp leading up to first week

Staff remain on site for duration of summer
