God bless you for all of you who came. You are very courageous people. The life we are living in, we don't control our life. There is somebody else who controls our life. These days we have this very serious coronavirus. And America named it a pandemic. And it's very scary. People who came from Africa, we had Ebola. And they were saying it was just because of monkeys in Congo. And we were stunned. And those are things that came from Congo.

Now, America and China are telling each other it's you, it's you, and having these protests. I don't know how you think about this, it's a disease you can get just from the breath, just from breathing on someone.

There is nowhere where we are told in the last days it will be peaceful. And there is nowhere where it is written that people who believe in God will have peace. But we have something beyond what other people have. We believe and trust in God. The reason why all you guys came this day, it's because you believe in God. There are other people following us online, and also they believe. It was requested, because some people have a lower immune system, to stay home. And they did so. Normally this is not how things are. Some people are in bed right now, other people are in their living rooms.

And we all have got to wait in line at the store for food. Toilet paper is ran out at the stores. I went to shop the other day, I needed something. And there was a big huge line, and I said, I cannot wait in this line, I'm going back.

But it is only this virus that came be going through the breath that we breathe. We must always be consistent to wash our hands. In Africa we had another epidemic called cholera, it came and passed. People would lose consciousness, [inaudible] and life continued. There is something said and it is true: we are not supposed to just ignore what we are supposed to do. But if your nation is going through this virus, no matter how you can mask yourself, no matter how many times you can wash your hands, people are very scared.

It is going to be difficult, but I'm telling you this: people who believe in God, He will heal them. Those who trust in God, He will help them through the very bad disease. Amen. To trust in God is not to commit suicide. To trust in God is just to trust in your mind and whatever's in your heart.

In late January I was in Israel. And I thought about how people went in a boat with Jesus, and he took a nap, and people were really scared. I went on that boat, too. When you are on that boat, and the waves are hitting, you aren't feeling very well. But Jesus, when he saw they were very scared, and he was quiet, and they were really scared and didn't know what to do. They woke him up. They said to him, how come, Jesus, you don't even care about what's going on right now?

Even now, people are saying this right now. We're scared, we could go all into the churches to pray. It's our only refuge, that's where we can find our refuge, that's the only place we can go now. From the President, whenever he gives his statement, he was tested yesterday to see how he's doing. It wasn't easy for him either. They found out he was negative.

From the President of the United States, whenever he says something, it goes as he says. Many churches were closed today. In Rwanda, no churches were open today. And so many others. Back home, somehow, they don't even have enough equipment to protect themselves.

But now, I know our God, the God who never abandons, and God of all time. Yesterday, the President said if you are able to pray please do so. Let's read Psalm Chapter 9. 9, verse 10:

"Those who know your name trust in you, for you, Lord, have never forsaken those who seek you."

Those who know your name, us, and all of you who are online, and all others who are watching, all those who know His name. There is no way that, those who seek His name, that He will be ignoring them. Hallelujah. Amen.

All the issues that we go through in our lives, it's so many. You just heard many testimonies that we heard right now. Think of someone standing right here, thirty years old not knowing where she's gonna be. Thirty years. They might tell you it's possible for you to have cancer. She is very strong. When they tell you that it's possible for you to have cancer, it's really sad and scary, it feels like it's drilling you down. I want to tell you how she got so strong, she could be losing weight right now but she's not- she looks like somebody who is going to the gym. Cancer.

Last time I was being tested, last month, I was going through the test for people 50 and above. When they think something might be suspicious, they tell you to come back within three or five years. They told me to come back in ten years. I tell them that even the scanners couldn't touch me. It means you are clean, nothing is wrong with you. Do you see me getting sick? Have you seen me in a hospital? Because my father fed me really good. He promised me one thing. He told me, you're gonna last long, so you can work and serve me. He told me this when I was in high school back home. In my eleventh grade. Junior year.

I was praying. He gave me those promises. Even this building was included. He gave me [inaudible] I'm gonna run through the Burundi, Congo, and how I'm gonna come here. And how I'm gonna go back to Rwanda to do reconciliation. Think about that. He told me this in '82, 1982. In all I do, I didn't call myself to do this. That's why you don't see me with any fear. I don't have any fear. I walk through my promises with God. I just put a dot in Burundi, where I met with Pastor Jeremy's dad, I knew him before, but that's when I met with him again. And to see all the blessings that he has given him.

In all circumstances that you can go through, we have God we can trust no matter how things might look. We said that Jesus went with his disciples in the boat and they woke him up. This virus that is on right now, remember this is somehow the reason God wants us to be closer to Him. Run away from what can kill your heart. And confess our sins, because we are close to the end of this world.

There's no other place that we can run to. And the hospital, we can't run to it. Our President, we can't run to him. Any other person, we cannot run to him. But God is our refuge. Whenever things get harder, whenever we are sick, whenever we are hungry, whenever things turn very hard and we don't know what to do. Amen.

I thought about how many people have been sick already. 2,752 people. 59 people already died. 139 in Massachusetts are sick. Connecticut and Rhode Island, 20 people are sick. New Hampshire, 70 people. Vermont, 4 people. Maine, 3 people. No matter where those three people are [all laughing].

I thought about if this virus was brought by Satan. Do you see how churches are very targeted? We are given a very open space to worship. Thank you so much for all of you who came. Thank you so much for running to God. Amen.

Our refuge is in the house of the Lord. If the virus kills us here, if anybody else dies, it's gonna be here, we're gonna say our farewells to him or her. Amen.

Where is your refuge? Is it in the hospital? Is it at work? There is nothing else that can bring this sort of situation, only Satan can. We believe that all diseases come from Satan. So to say that Satan is controlling the whole world, and God sends all of us to bless Him here. Amen.

And many others are sitting apart. Our lives are into God's hands. How many people have been involved in car accidents? 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7. 8. And I have faced many. Almost, like, 5. And they hit me in the back. And it's an accident [inaudible]. And the police came, it was an accident. It wasn't that big. Maybe it was because of the snow. Is there anyone who was involved in an accident and some people died? [Looking around] No one. Have you seen other people that have gotten into a car accident, but they came out? Have you seen an airplane crash that one or two people survived? Who do those people remain alive, and others die?

It's because the day of their death was not there yet. Another thing, it's for him or her to have a testimony to share. The reason why we are here, we are remaining, people who were in Rwanda, people who were in Burundi and Congo and all the other places, you say how many people were dying while you were passing by.

There was a time that flu came. And many people died. In this country 675,000 people. And they died. America is still alive. I want to just tell you to not be afraid. The one that we trust, who

created us, he created us, and he created us, and he gave us the breath that we breathe. He is still alive. He's still alive.

I read the Word of God, saying how we are vessels. Vessels. Amen. Vessels. A person who makes those vessels, of clay. Somebody was making clay, and made that pot in a very nice way. But at the end of the day it did not work well. There was a small stone inside. When they took it out, then that pot became cleaner and better. We are just the clay in the pot that was made by God. And I believe, through all this going on today, He can make us again better. And He can give us more faith to trust. He can give us again another way of praising the Lord. There's another day we're gonna come and say praise the Lord for what He has done. Thank you Jesus, we have overcome. Hallelujah. Amen.

We have overcome. Even Ebola we have overcome. Even coronavirus we are going to overcome. And I'm going to ask you to stand up, all of you here today. The worship team come forward here. And we are going to pray for coronavirus. We are all going to pray that God is going to help us. Help our nation here in the United States, the nation where we came from, and the whole world. God is going to do it. No matter the fear we have. God did not give us the spirit of fear. He gave us courage. He praises those who are courageous. Be strong. Be strong. Be strong. Be strong. We are going to pray, all of us. We are going to chase away Satan and all the strength of coronavirus when we are praying together. So God can do good to us. So we can be a very good bridge to all other people. Hallelujah. Amen.
