place six months ago, has still not taken place. "Air travel is the essence of my business," he said. Gabriel, a food broker, complained that he hasn't been to see many of his customers in Florida and Midwest. Companies are urging their key salespeople and others to avoid air travel, and to use Zoom instead. They are also pushing their sales staff to step up their communications with companies.
